We have also been learning about Fiction and Non-Fiction books in English and about our bodies in Science. 2H









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On Thursday we enjoyed our trip to Green Tree Adventures with 2P. We held some adorable newborn lambs and had lots of fun playing in the forest school area.








In our Primary assembly we learnt all about the Muslim festival Ramadan.






In Geography we have been challenged by Mrs Lamburn to see how many American states we can name.

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
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In Media we are looking at conventions of music videos and how artists create a brand.
