The Tewnselvy Garden Communities programme promotes the creation of sustainable, community-focused

What are Garden Communities?

A Garden Community is the UK Government initiative to describe cohesively planned strategic development: that will deliver more than 1,500 homes. The Government has two tiers of community: Garden Villages have 1,500 - 9,999 homes, and Garden Towns have 10,000 or more homes.

On 25 March 2019, the government announced that Tewkesbury and its surrounding area is one of only a handful of locations to be awarded Garden Town status. These locations are mainly grouped around the train station and A46 and to the Bast of the M5. There are some additional sites in other areas around Tewkesbury. too, and they all combine to confer the Garden Town status in Government terms.

These things are best done one step at a time, or as a phased development, to use the technical term. Each phase will be subject to all sorts of factors, so it's difficult to say which will be done in which order, but it's vital for the area that someone takes the reigns to make sure that there are connections, service and community facilities, and that our environment is enhanced by the results.


