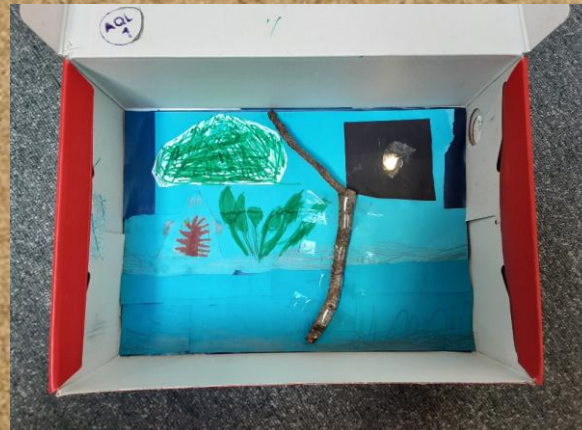
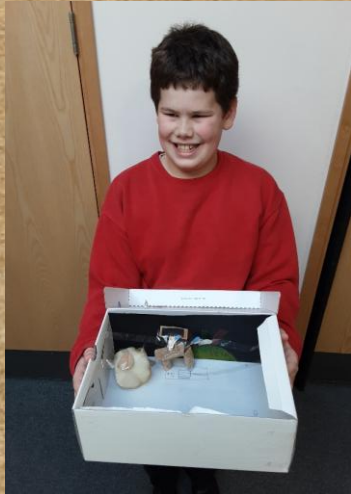

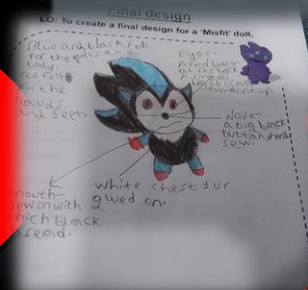
STITCH HEAD

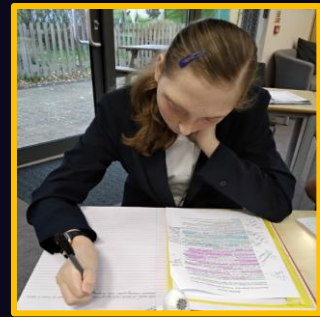
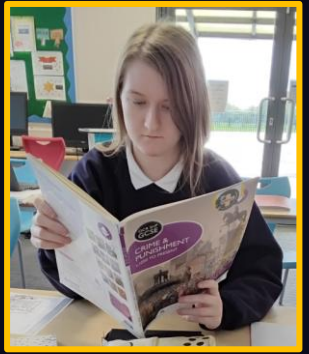
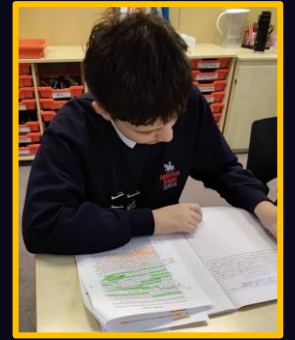
Key Stage 4

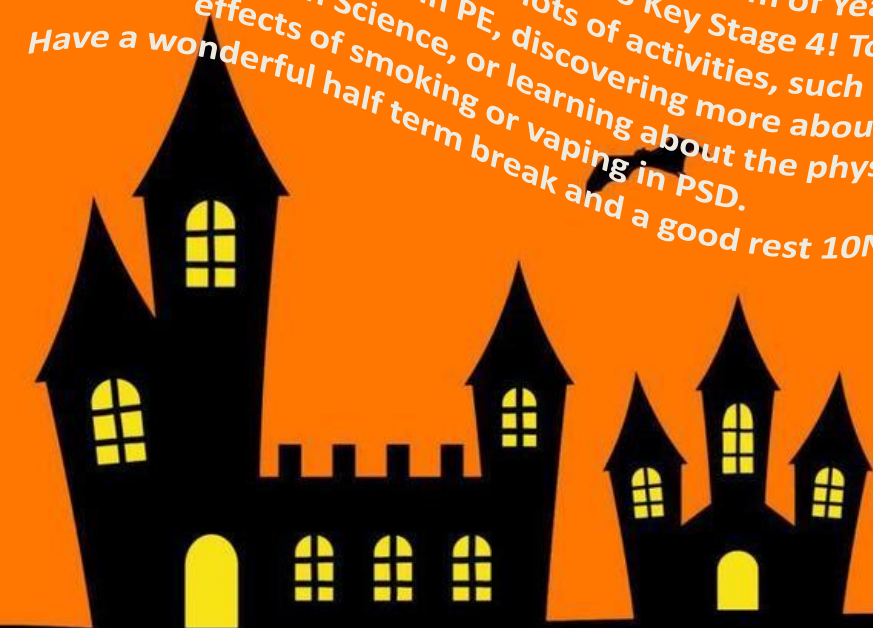


Alderman Knight School
