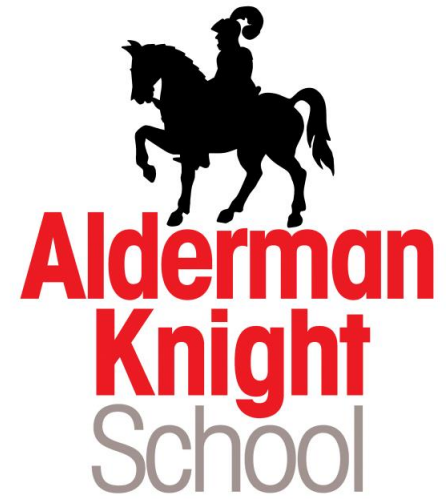


**Week Commencing 5th May 2025**

planes; we then raced them against each other.





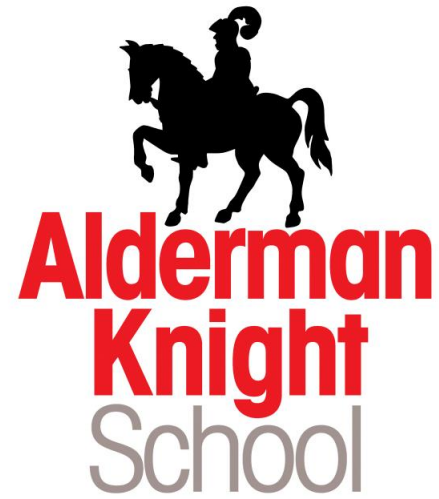

In Art, everyone started developing their ideas in their jellyfish project where they will be making sculptures inspired by the Washed Ashore Project.



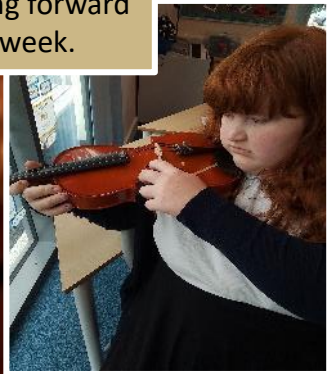

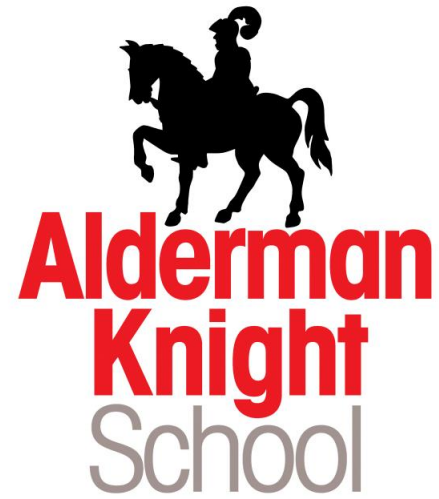

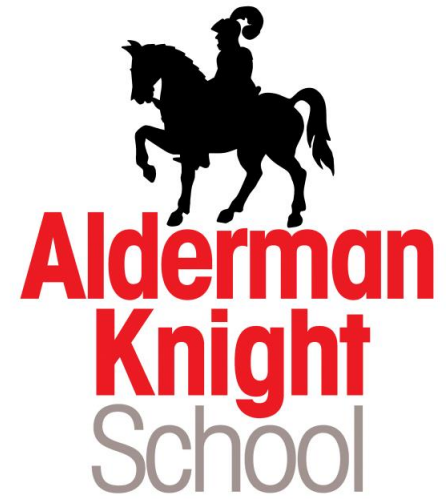

Three students from 13W joined in the VE Day 80 celebrations at Marina Court Care Home.

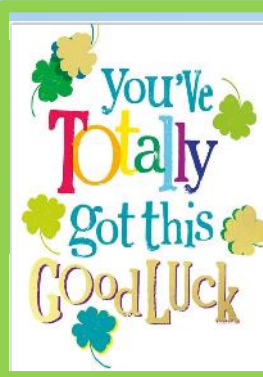

Students studying Design and Technology have been disassembling and reassembling vacuum cleaner tools as part of preparation for their coursework.



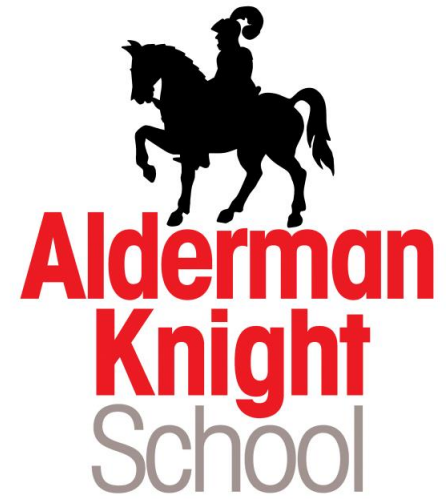

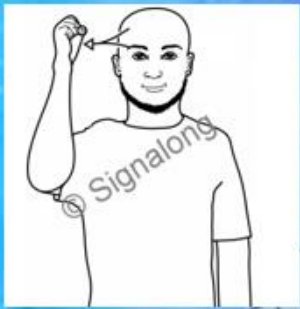
