




In **Science**, pupils conducted an experiment to see whether salt, sugar, sand and flour are soluble or insoluble.





In Food, we made one of the Spanish dishes, paella! It was quite a difficult lesson as we need to cut the ingredients using 2 different boards.

















In Drama this term, we are looking at 'Wind in The Willows' by Kenneth Grahame.




Some of us created cardioids in Maths this week.







Huge thanks to Holly in Year 11 for sharing her excellent speech on Autism with us. 9K listened beautifully to every single word!








In Food this week, the remaining half of the class worked






Well done everyone for completing your Mock Exams over the last few weeks, you have all done incredibly well and should be proud of yourselves!
