

English

In English we will be using this short term to focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar. This will include looking at different sentence types and how to punctuate these accurately. We will also be learning about root words, and how we can use prefixes and suffixes to spell longer words. In term 6, we will be applying these skills in a non-fiction unit

Maths

Throughout the Summer Term, we will be applying our calculation skills in other areas of Maths. We will learn about fractions and decimals, as well as the shape, space and measure aspects of Mathematics. We will also be learning how to tell the time, on analogue and digital clocks.

Science

Term 5: We will be learning about plants, including their structure, variety and life cycle. We will build on our knowledge of living things, and develop our scientific skills in experiments.

Term 6: In our last Science unit, we will learn about seasonal changes, weather and how to gather and interpret data.

Humanities

In History, we will learn about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. Starting with the Palaeolithic era, we will learn what people ate, and how diet and houses changed with the discovery of farming. We will also look at artefacts and what they can teach us about prehistoric people. In Geography, we will learn about continents and oceans, as well as developing our map reading skills.

Art/DT/Food

In Art, we will looking at Stone Age cave paintings. We will then experiment with making similar tools to those used in the Stone Age, before creating our own Stone Age inspired masterpieces! In DT, we will look at how structures changed during the Stone Age, as well as creating our own models of Mesolithic or Neolithic buildings. In our food technology lessons, we will continue to develop basic cooking skills, as well as preparing cooked dishes.

Music

In Music this term, pupils will be learning to sing and play along to a variety of songs based on the story of Treasure Island. Musical styles they will learn about range from rock and roll to rap, blues to waltz. Pupils will learn to practice and present a performance, learn to sing in two parts and play instruments with increased accuracy.
