We had 29 pupils in our Year 11 Cohort for 2024-2025.

GCSE and Graded Vocational results for Year 11 (percentage at each grade)

In June 2025, 77 GCSE examinations were sat by Year 11 Pupils. A further 9 'graded' qualifications were sat by Year 11 pupils – (where these grades can be aligned to GCSE grades).

- 21 of the 29 pupils (72.4% of the Cohort) sat one or more GCSE examinations.
- 21 of the 77 GCSE examinations (27.3% of examinations sat) were awarded a Grade 4+. A further five were achieved through Hospitality and Catering.
- 42 of the 77 GCSE examinations (55.6% of examinations sat) were awarded a Grade 3+. A further 9 were achieved through Hospitality and Catering.
