






**2R**

It's been a great week for 2R. In maths we have continued to learn the value of money during our role play shop. In PE we had lots of fun playing some parachute games.





We held a concert to showcase all that we have learned in Violin and some parents came to watch as well as other classes.





John B was the fastest out of all pupils and adults in the cup stacking at the summer fayre. Well done John.






Learning all about measurements. We were able to measure the height of each student to know who was the tallest and shortest of 3M.



In drama this week, we played a game of keeper's keys, as well as other team building activities.



Baking and decorating a vanilla tray bake, beautifully decorated with butter and sprinkles.






4R were fortunate enough to be chosen to listen to some key stage three pupils perform on the violin. What a masterpiece it was!




