





Week Beginning: 25th April 2022

Our new science topic this term is plants, we have been labelling the different parts of a plant and planting our own seeds, with one of 2B's plant starting to grow already!!




During the Easter term we were lucky to have a new trim trail built in the playground at Alderman Knight, 2B have really enjoyed spending time exploring the area.

2E have had a super busy first week back! The children have really enjoyed using the new trim Trail at break and lunch times and have started their new topic – Stone Age.




In music 2E have started playing the recorder and learnt how to play the note 'B'.





In forest school we planted potato seeds and got very messy exploring the new mud kitchen.



We all got the opportunity to stitch a stitch in the Tewkesbury stitch story. We are all part of Tewkesbury history!




We have started our new topic - plays. We had some very beautiful princesses, some cunning dragons, snoozing guards, brave knights and some crafty fairies!






In Music we used a new computer program to play a drum machine.

We had a great Science lesson testing substances with universal indicator paper to find out if they were acid or alkaline.




We had good fun playing shops to work out how much change we need when we don't have the right money. Thank you, Miss Fisher, our new maths teacher.




Finishing touches to our birdhouses in DT.





This week we did out some acting in our lessons. We had Princesses, Fairies, Dragons and Knights.



We have started our new topic for the term, Cricket. We were learning how to bat.








Finally, we have filled our marble jar all the way to the top. We are all so excited to receive our class treat!




In P.E, we have started to do athletics. This week, we are learning how to throw a javelin correctly.




Libby has been such a great helper this week. Well done!

In Music, 4B used Bandlab Education on the laptops to create music with drums.





It has been a busy start to term 5 and it has been great to hear everyone's news.


4C really enjoy our singing lessons this week. In singing we played a fun game called The Music Inspector. Before learning a new song.

We enjoyed hearing about how everybody spent the holiday, whether at home or away. 😊





After some changes, the library looks fab, 4W loved being back in there for reading again this week.


