

English

We will start Autumn 1 with a fantastic series of lessons based around an Icelandic traditional tale. This will be followed by diary writing (linked to Samuel Pepys), then list poems. In Autumn 2, we will base our writing on familiar stories from the UK, before finishing with non-chronological reports. Reading, spelling and handwriting will also be developed this term.

Maths

We will begin with learning about place value, with this knowledge then applied within addition, subtraction, multiplication and division later this term. Also this term, we will develop our understanding of shape, length and height, time and money; all of which will be further developed later this year.

This term, we will learn about: Animals including humans, Earth and Space, Light and Sound, Materials, Seasonal Changes and Forces and magnets. All of these will be revisited and explored in greater detail later on in the school year.
