

## English

In English this term, we will be following the Read Write Inc. framework in order to develop our phonics, reading and writing. There will be a particular focus on spelling, grammar and punctuation. We will also use some English time to focus on our speech, language and communication. We will be reading books for pleasure with a specific focus on our science topic of plants. We will be reading "Olivers Vegetables".

## Maths

In Maths this term, we will be learning about time and money. We will be thinking about our daily timetables, days, months and years as well as looking at clocks and how we can begin to tell the time. During Summer term 2, we will focus on Money, identifying different coins and notes as well as other ways to pay for things.

## Science

Summer Term 1: We will be looking at the lifecycle of plants. We will complete a range of different experiments, ensuring that we are working scientifically. We will also be planting a range of different vegetables, linking to our story "Oliver's Vegetables"

Summer Term 2: We will be exploring different seasonal changes and how this looks like, in the environment that we live in.

## Humanities

Our topic for the term is Knights and Castles.

In Summer Term 1, we will be focusing on the history of Knights and Castles and the impact that Knights have had, on our world as we know it now. We will explore the different jobs that people had, within castles.

In Summer Term 2, we will be focussing on the geographical aspect of Knights and Castles. We will be looking at where Knights travelled and where we can find castles in England.

## Religious Education

During the summer term, we will continue to think about special people, places and festivals. We will be focussing on the Muslim faith, learning about what Muslims believe in, their places of worship and their special festivals.

## Art/DT/Food

In Art this term, we are looking at colour, prints and patterns, linking this to Oliver's Vegetables.

In DT, we are going to make castles, using a range of recycled materials. We will look at joining materials together, as well as creating small mechanisms.

In Food, we will continue to develop our chopping skills of different vegetables, and will begin to identify how vegetables can be used within a range of sweet and savoury foods.

## Music

This term we will be learning a variety of songs, based on the story Jack and the beanstalk, linking to the science topic of plants. We will be singing songs in unison.

## PE

Pupils will continue to access weekly Rebound Therapy sessions, where we are continuing to establish our individualised sequences and routines.

Throughout the summer term, we will also be focussing on Athletics. We will be learning about the standing long jump, sprinting and javelin. Pupils will take part in both practical and theoretical lessons, where we will begin to think about the impact that physical activity has on our bodies.
