





2E worked very hard to complete their stone-age homes. They used neutral paint tones and added natural materials to give it a realistic look.






2R have worked hard in their phonics sessions this week. In maths we made up a rhyme to remember o'clock and half past. Well done 2R for a great week!





3E have been having loads of fun in the sun at the end of the day!




We have moved on to Hour Of Code in ICT. We have been programming an app!


In PE we have moved on to sprinting and in maths we have looked at ratio and spotting sequences in numbers. In Music we continued to practice with bows in violin.

The time has finally arrived for our Young Voices Concert. Holly and Adam are very excited. Look out for the pictures next week.





In food, we made vegetable frittatas. Most of us tasted our creations and thoroughly enjoyed them.




We have been trying hard in PE this term, we have begun learning different techniques and taken part in lots of fun activities.
