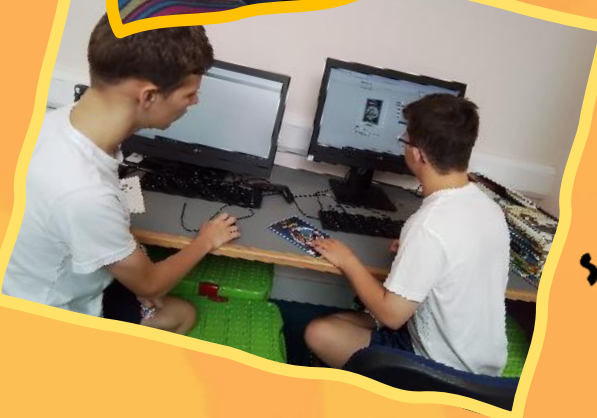
We have all absolutely loved welcoming our new classmate Jack into 9N this week – thank you to the group for making him feel so welcome!
