

What a brilliant term this has been, lots of fun, laughter and so much progress made, well done 2B! Enjoy the summer holidays and see you all in September.



First Day in 2P – September 2021







In our last English lesson, we had fun doing some free reading in Mr. Ms new reading corner! There were loads of toys and bean bags.





For PE, because of the heat we have been in the hall, but it was still exciting.


On Wed 3G went to Skill Zone, where we learnt how to keep ourselves safe in lots of different situations.

The bunting is being finished for the end of the year in DT.





We then went to Twynning where we had a picnic and played in the park.







On Tuesday, we had a smaller group than usual, due to the very hot weather. We made sure to stay cool and found plenty of ways to have fun despite the extreme temperatures.




In 3S this term, we have excelled in our reading, we enjoy reading different genres and some of us even enjoy acting out our stories!






The Hospitality & Catering group got to use their skills for real again, this time helping to prepare and serve food at the Pied Piper 30th Anniversary party.






