


Fantastic last week!

We enjoyed having Amelie in on Tuesday. We read to her, brushed her and gave her lots of cuddles.


This week 2E have been completing the daily Wordle at the start of their English lessons. 2E have learnt some exciting new words and have managed to guess the word within 5 tries every time!

We have done lots of group work this week. 2E have showed excellent team work and great social skills.




3M have been working hard this term to complete the new DT project. We have designed a creature feature to hold stationery.

This week we have been using Google Blockly and Python to do some coding.







We have had some time to play games and we got to see Fudge the therapy dog at breaktime.




3P have enjoyed working together on Easter Maths challenges.

In ICT, we are working our way through purple mash. We are very excited to design our avatars.




