

2R finished making their plushies in DT. They worked very hard, designing them and learning to sew them together.
























2R had a brilliant time at Horse-Riding this week. They practiced trotting and balancing on the horse by catching and throwing bean bags and attempting to stand up.


7D

We have been learning about equivalent fractions in Maths






