



In Science we have started a plant growth investigation. The boys had to work together to follow all the steps needed to complete the investigation.











This week in cooking we made a delicious Easter tray bake, using yummy chocolate and mini eggs. We used the electrical mixers which was quite tricky, but we persevered.



In English, Post-16 have been performing their spoken language work to the class.










In GCSE Art, Year 12 have been exploring paper sculptures by the artist Andy Singleton. These are some of their creations, along with some from Year 10.


