

Alderman Knight School: Achievement 2023-2024



As a Special School with high expectations of pupils' and students' academic development, we are very proud of all the results shown below that the pupils/students have achieved from their individual starting points. These academic achievements, that we publish on our website, are only part of the picture though and we also celebrate and recognise the progress in personal development, independence and preparation for adulthood that all pupils and students have made, and know that all our leavers are able to look forward to their next steps with confidence and enthusiasm.

2023-2024 Key Stage 2 School Results

There were 24 pupils in the Year 6 cohort who were assessed against National Standards. 9 pupils took one or more of the KS2 SATs papers. The summary of these outcomes are shown in the table below.

- 3 of the pupils have reached the expected standard scale score of 100 in reading. A further 2 near to expected standard with scaled scores of 95 or more.
- 1 of the pupils was very close to expected standard in Speaking, Listening and Grammar with a scaled score of 98.
- 2 of the pupils were near to expected standard in Mathematics with scaled scores of 95 or more.

2023-2024 Key Stage 4 School Results

We had 28 pupils in our Year 11 Cohort for 2023-2024.

GCSE and Graded Vocational results for Year 11 (percentage at each grade)

In June 2024, 57 GCSE examinations were sat by Year 11 Pupils. A further 19 'graded' qualifications were sat by Year 11 pupils – (where these grades can be aligned to GCSE grades).

- 22 of the 28 pupils (78.6% of the Cohort) sat one or more GCSE examinations.
- 14 of the 57 GCSE examinations (24.6% of examinations sat) were awarded a Grade 4+. A further 3 were achieved through Hospitality and Catering.
- 31 of the 57 GCSE examinations (54.4% of examinations sat) were awarded a Grade 3+. A further 4 were achieved through Hospitality and Catering.

Post 16 Results

GCSE Results for Post 16 (percentage at each grade) for all students in our Post 16 provision

In June 2024, 40 GCSE examinations were sat by Year 13 Students. A further 3 'graded' qualifications were sat by Year 13 Students – (where these grades can be aligned to GCSE grades).

- 8 of the 40 GCSE examinations (20.0% of examinations sat) were awarded a Grade 4+. A further 1 was achieved through Food and Catering.
- 17 of the 40 GCSE examinations (42.5% of examinations sat) were awarded a Grade 3+. A further 2 were achieved through Food and Catering.

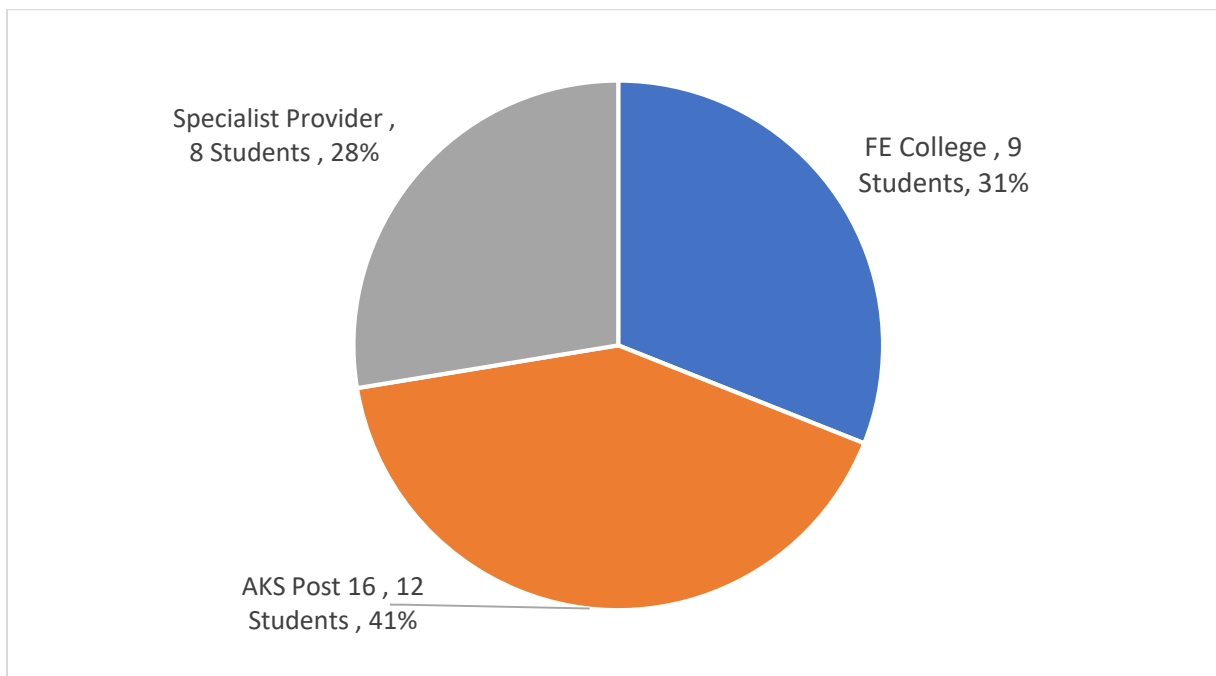

For 2023-2024 we had 29 Y11 leavers who are all now in education, employment or training. 100% of year 11 leavers have made a successful transition to their next destination and are attending their course.

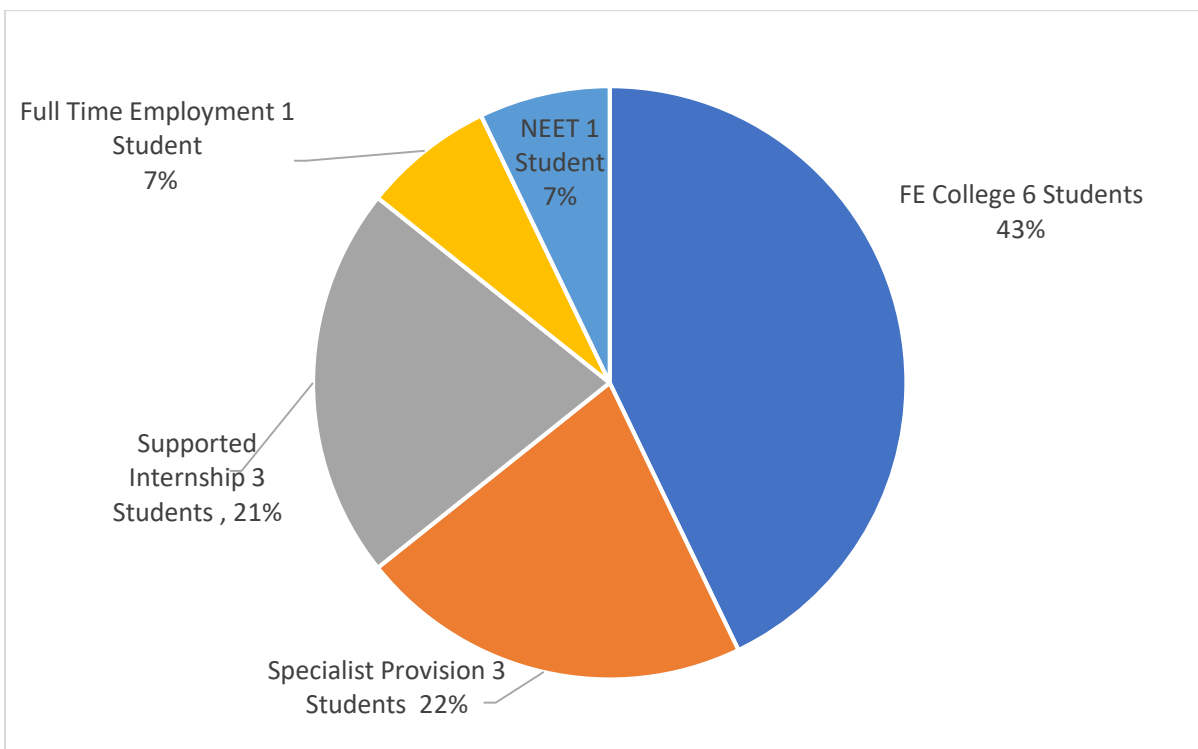
Y11 Leavers Destinations
