




In Food we discussed healthy living and organised some common foods into calorie order. We were all shocked to see which foods contained more calories than another















































Inspired by a book we read called 'A River' 8W used watercolours to create their own journey paintings.




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Our topic this term in Science is all about molecules. This week, we have enjoyed learning about atoms, elements and compounds.

In PSD we learned what a job application form might look like and what information an employer might want from us.



In English and Maths the Year 13s have been working through past exam papers to help prepare for the Mocks.




Mrs Weston's Essential Skills group have been planning a trip out to have lunch after the Mocks have finished.


